PS: The planning meeting is open to all members, regular attendees, and students.

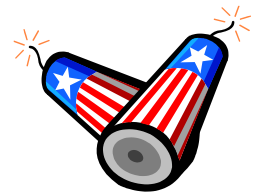

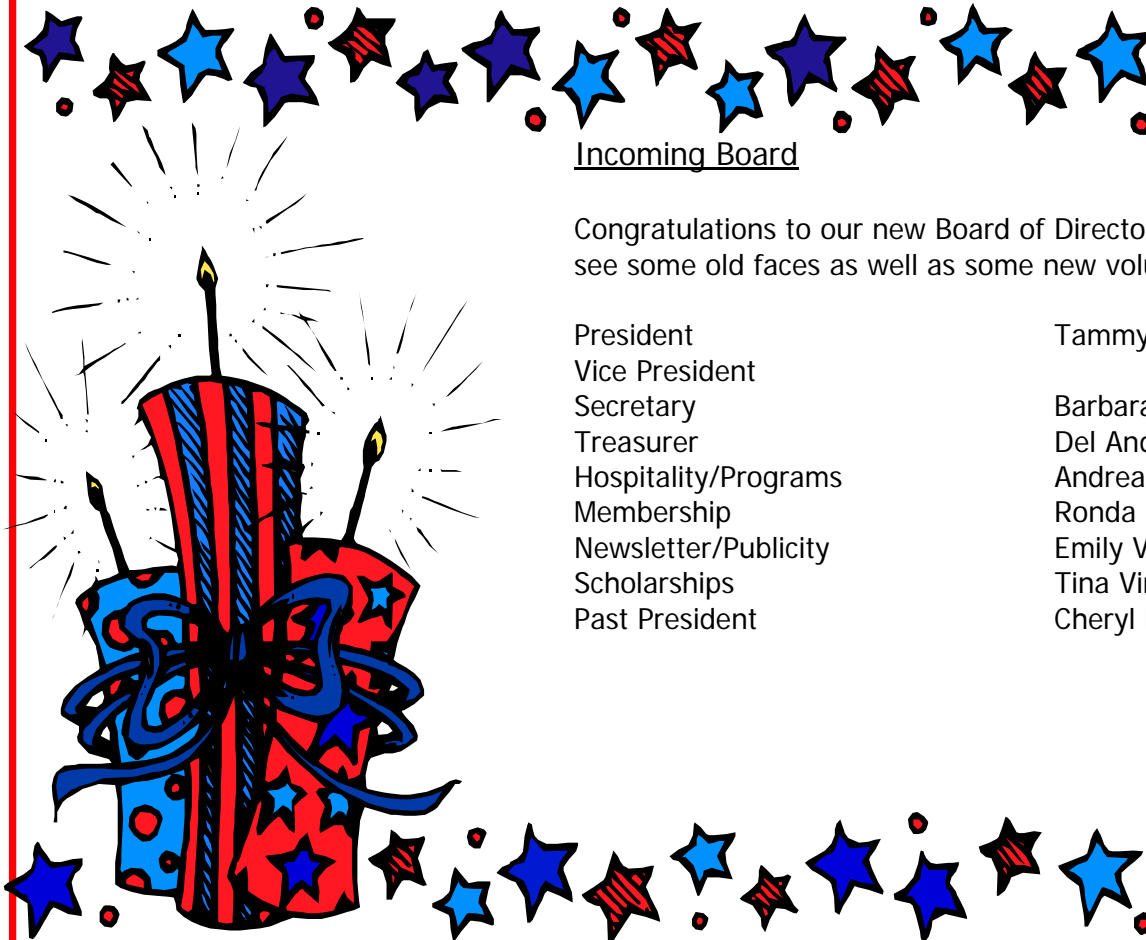

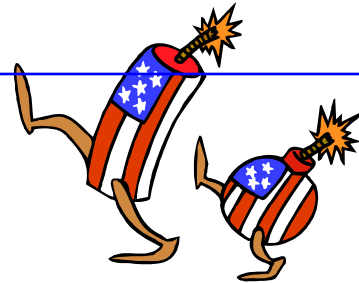
